- 26 million Adherents

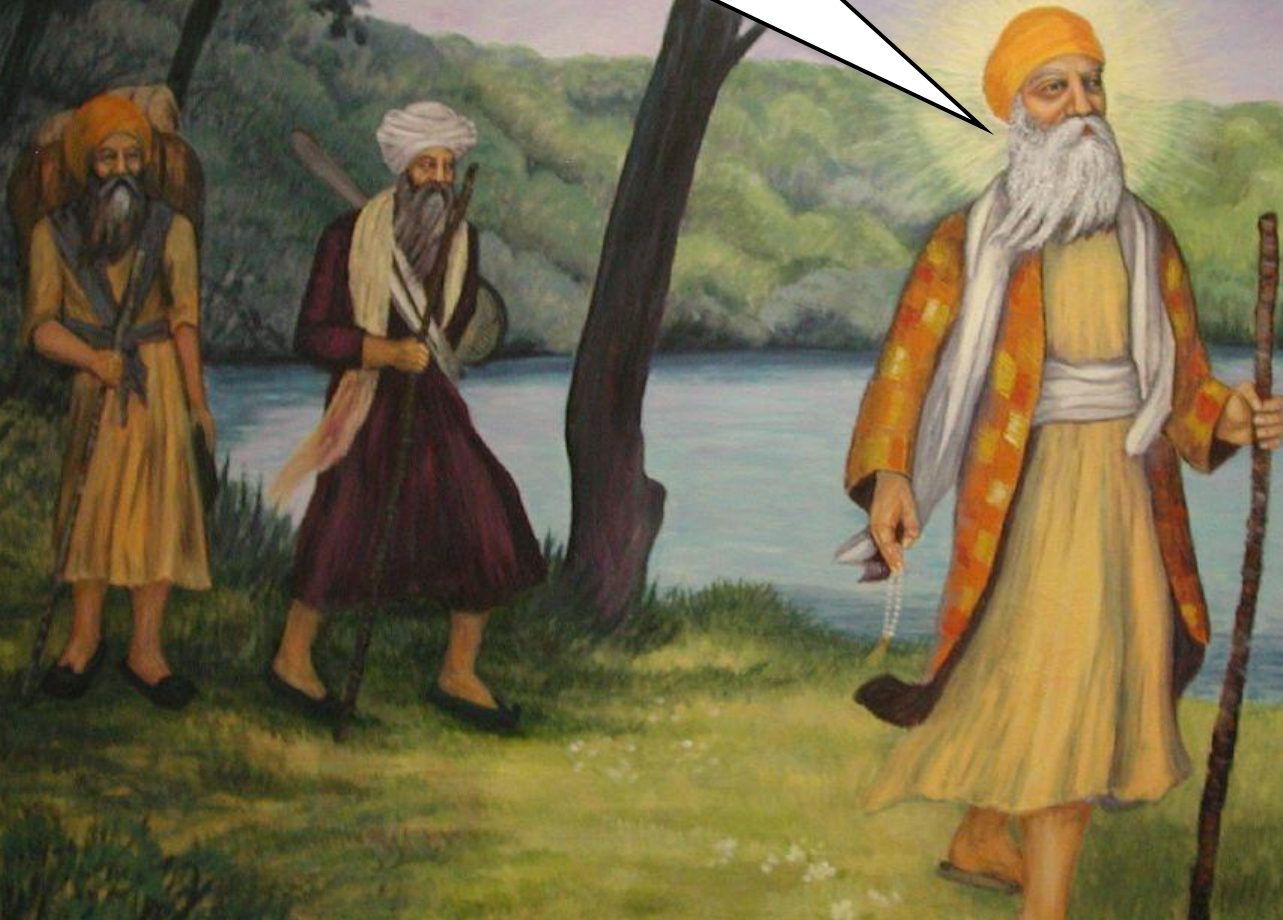
